



Mr. Mahendra Siregar has been Vice Minister of Foreign Affairs since October 2019.

Mr. Siregar is formerly the Ambassador of the Republic of Indonesia to the United States (2019), the Chairman of Indonesian Investment Coordinating Board (2013-2014), the Vice Minister of Finance (2011-2013), and the Vice Minister of Trade (2009-2011).

Apart from his tenures as a government official, Mahendra also held various positions in corporations and international organization. He was the Executive Director of the Council of Palm Oil Producing Countries (2017-2019) and former commissioner of various companies in resources, technology, consumers and financial service industries.
